Motion to accept the bid by Todd Heckman by Elder 2nd by Fairlamb

Supervisors recognize Thad Hall from the County Board of Elections, Mr. Hall wanted to discuss the possibility of moving the polling place for Lake Township from the Township building to a church in Stoneboro. Mr. Hall after touring the facility earlier in the month has concerns about the handicap accessibility for voting, specifically the designated handicap parking spot and the ramp coming into the Township building. The Supervisors and Mr. Hall discussed what necessary code updates would require as their initial response is to keep the polling at the Township building. Mr. Hall will send approved specs for both a handicap ramp and parking

spot. The Supervisors asked if they could take some time before deciding. No decision will need to be made until April, 2022.

Roadmaster Report:

The 1995 small dump truck is out for repairs. Snow removal has gone better with Supervisor Elder and Jonathan Scheistle rotating in the large plow truck and Supervisor Gander using his own truck and plow.

Bills where approved and paid.

Motion by Elder 2nd by Fairlamb to accept the bid from Solid Rock Roofing to replace the roof on the Township building for \$44,650.00 to start as soon as possible. Interior damage due to the roof leaking will become severe if not addressed soon.

Motion by Gander 2nd by Fairlamb to get phone quotes for hauling for 2022 for next month meeting.

The Supervisors signed a Resolution 2022-01 to join the Delaware COG for 2022 for Tar and Chip.
